Summer Concert 1973

The concert on 10th July contained a variety of choral and instrumental items. The combined Grammar and High School Junior Choirs sang "Animal Magic" by Gordon Jacob. The Concert Band played an "English Folk Song Suite" by Vaughan-Williams, and the Grammar School Choir ended the programme with "Mutiny on the Cutty Sark" by John Parry and Ian Humphries.

Ostler, played the slow movement of Schumann's piano Concerto (soloist: Mark Hunt), and a "Slavonic Dance" by Dvorak. The programme concluded with the Choral Dances from "Prince Igor" by Borodin, sung by the Senior Choirs, and conducted by Mr. A. Chesters.

- 26th October, 1973: Mr. B. W. APPLEBY (Music Master 1932-1939)
Mr. Appleby, the School's first Music Master presented the Appleby House Music Cup to the School when he left to join Doncaster Grammar School.
